LENTILS

Laird Lentils

Large, green whole lentils known for their mild, earthy flavour and firm texture. Popular in soups, salads, and casseroles, these lentils retain shape after cooking, making them ideal for Mediterranean and Canadian cuisines.



Red Football Lentils

Robust whole red lentils with a football-like round shape, widely used in South Asian, Middle Eastern, and North African dishes. They are rich in protein and fibre, supporting heart health and dietary needs.

Whole Red Lentils

Small whole red lentils with husk removed. They cook quickly while maintaining a slightly firm texture, making them perfect for stews, dal preparations, and protein-rich meals.

Red Split Lentils

Husked and split red lentils that soften easily when cooked. They are a staple in Indian dals and soups, with a slightly sweet and nutty taste, making them suitable for quick nutritious meals.

Moong Whole (Green Gram Whole)

Small green lentils with husk, highly valued for their high protein content and digestibility. Used extensively in curries, sprouts, and traditional Asian savoury dishes, they are known to aid weight management and digestion.



Moong Dal Chilka (Split Green Gram with Husk)

Split green gram with husk intact, offering a balance of fibre and protein. Ideal for traditional dals, savoury pancakes, and soups, contributing to heart health and digestive wellness.

Toor Dal (Pigeon Peas)

Yellow split pigeon peas, an essential pulse in Indian households for making thick, creamy dals with a mild, nutty flavour. High in protein, folic acid, and dietary fibre.



Urad Gota (Whole White Lentils)

Whole white lentils without skin, highly valued for their creamy texture when cooked. Commonly used in South Indian idli and dosa batters, and for tempering in North Indian dishes.

Urad Whole (Black Gram Whole with Husk)

Whole black gram with skin, known for its dense nutritional profile. Used in traditional Indian dals, curries, and fermented preparations for its rich protein and iron content.

Chana Dal (Split Chickpeas)

Yellow split chickpeas without skin, offering a nutty taste and firm texture. Used in Indian dals, savouries like namkeen, and flour production for sweets and snacks.



PEAS

Desi Chickpeas (Kala Chana)

Small brown chickpeas with a dense texture and earthy taste. Used widely in Indian, Pakistani, and Bangladeshi cuisines in curries, chaat, and flours. High in protein, iron, and dietary fibre.



Kabuli Chickpeas

Large creamy white chickpeas with a smooth texture. They are the key ingredient in hummus, falafel, Mediterranean salads, and stews, providing essential vitamins and minerals for a balanced diet.

Green Peas

Naturally sweet green peas, sourced fresh and dried for long shelf life. Commonly used in rice dishes, vegetable mixes, soups, and frozen packs. High in fibre, vitamins A, C, and K.

Split Green Peas

Husked and split green peas for quick cooking. Their creamy texture makes them ideal for thickening soups, purees, and stews, while adding rich plant-based protein to diets.

Yellow Peas

Mild-flavoured yellow peas, a staple in soups and flours. Used in Indian dal preparations, pea flour, and snack industries due to their high protein, B-vitamins, and mineral content.



BEANS

Light Red Kidney Beans

Medium-sized beans with a light red colour and smooth texture. Perfect for Mexican dishes, chilli, salads, and curries, these beans are rich in iron, potassium, and dietary fibre.



White Kidney Beans (Cannellini Beans)

Large white beans with a creamy texture and mild flavour. Widely used in Italian and Mediterranean cuisines in soups, stews, and salads, offering an excellent source of protein and folate.

Dark Red Kidney Beans

Deep red, glossy beans known for their robust flavour and ability to hold shape after cooking. Commonly used in chilli con carne, rajma curry, and global pulse blends, they are rich in protein, fibre, and essential minerals.

Brown Flax Seeds
